GARDINER DAM TERMINAL TO CONSTRUCT NEW CROP INPUT CENTER STRONGFIELD, SASKATCHEWAN –

Gardiner Dam Terminal Ltd. (GDT Ltd.), a co-venturer with Viterra Inc. in Gardiner Dam Terminal Joint Venture (“GDT JV”), is pleased to announce that GDT JV has approved construction of a full-service Crop Input center at Tullis, Saskatchewan.

Construction will begin in August of 2009 and management expects it to be functional late Fall of 2009. The Tullis facility will be financed with a combination of cash from operations and term debt granted through commercial financing. As security for financing, each of GDT Ltd. and Viterra Inc. have pledged their respective interests in specific project assets in favour of the lender.
